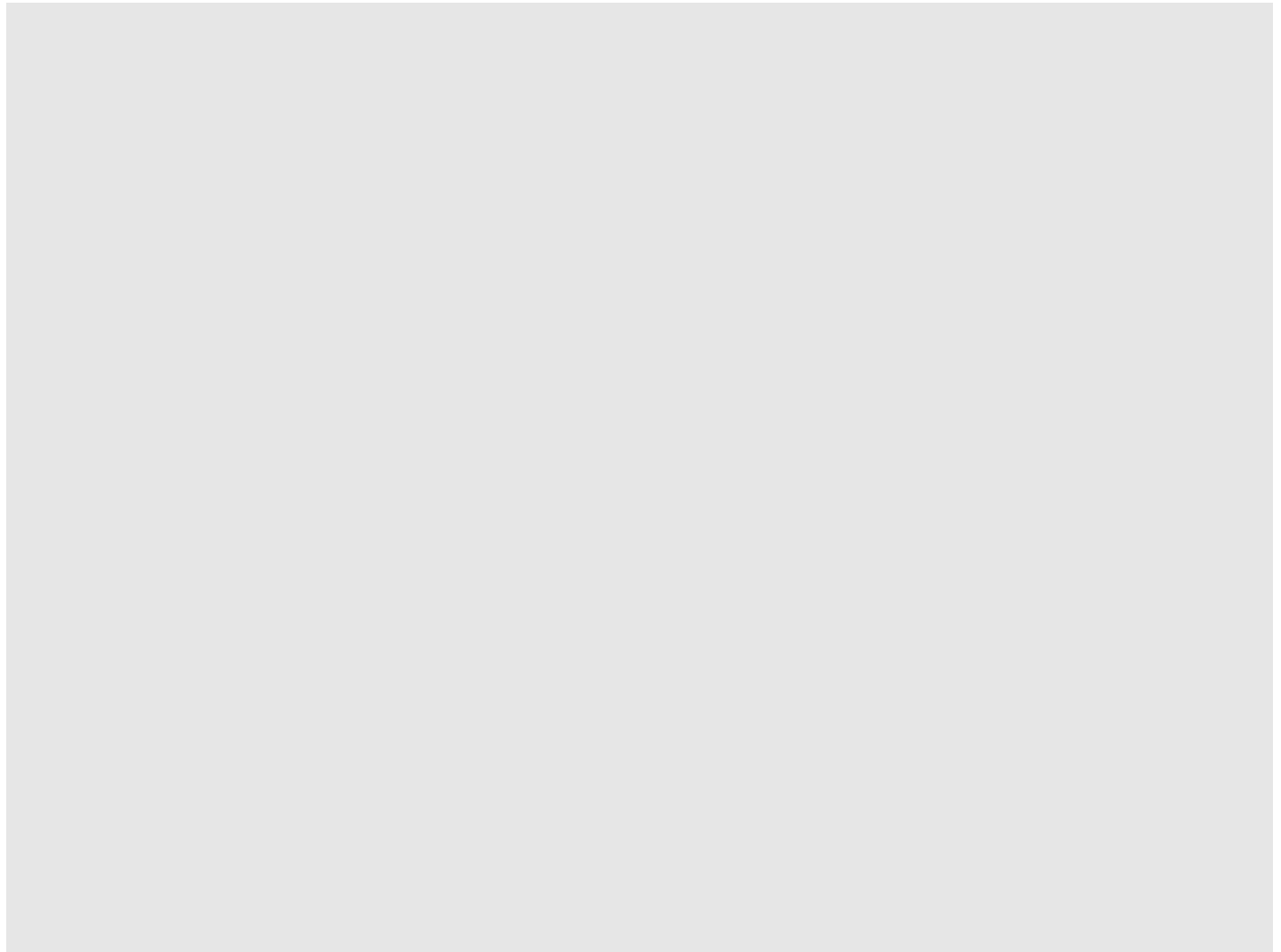

Benesch's Eisenberg named BTI client service all-star


