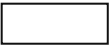
The City of Chicago announced several new legal hires.

Samuel Chae has joined the Office of Inspector General as an assistant inspector general. In his role, Chae provides legal direction and counsel for investigations involving violations of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the city's personnel rules, and the city's Governmental Ethics Ordinance, audits and public safety projects.

Silver Lin joined the OIG as an assistant inspector general. She primarily contributes to investigations by providing legal guidance. She has previously clerked at the 7th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals and spent a few years as a forensic accounting consultant.

Jaimie Grace joined the OIG as an associate staff attorney. In this position, Grace serves as the FOIA officer and responds to discovery and subpoenas in coordination with the City's Law Department.
