A sustaining gift of \$600,000 from Benesch will support the continuation of UH's innovative Medical Legal Partnership with The Legal Aid Society of Cleveland. Benesch is the program's founding partner and, since 2018, has positively impacted patient care at UH Rainbow Babies & Children's Ahuja Center for Women & Children through legal expertise and support; their renewed commitment will support a full-time, onsite attorney at the health center for an additional five years.

UH providers and Legal Aid attorneys work together to educate physicians, nurses, social workers and other clinical personnel about health-harming legal needs that may be affecting their patients. Those staff members then help identify and refer patients who need legal assistance. Cases can include assistance with public benefits such as Medicaid, educational concerns, housing needs, custody issues, and public utility problems.
