Benesch Corporate & Securities Partner Aslam Rawoof was featured in Agenda's article, "Outspoken' Director Resignations May Suggest Governance Failures." Aslam said, speaking generally and not about any specific company or situation, "If I see that a director resigned due to a disagreement, given how extremely rare they are, I would think that something very significant must have happened."

The article highlights Intel's broader challenges, including potential activist threats, competition, and the need for greater transparency in director resignation disclosures. Governance professionals warn that public airing of grievances can harm board members' prospects and expose them to litigation risks while negatively impacting the company's stock price and reputation. A new study suggests disclosing director resignations could alert investors to systemic issues and improve corporate governance.
