Gregg Eisenberg

Serving as Benesch's Managing Partner since 2015, Gregg's visionary leadership has led to the firm significantly expanding its footprint and market presence by successfully opening offices in Chicago, San Francisco and New York. His lateral growth strategy has resulted in more than 370 attorneys joining the firm, bringing it to more than 450 attorneys today. Gregg has overseen a \$266 million (326%) increase in revenue during his tenure and a 68-spot advancement on the Am Law 200 since the firm's 2017 debut on the list.

In addition to serving as Managing Partner, Gregg maintains an active corporate practice representing some of the nation's largest corporate buyers and private equity firms. He is deeply involved in the Cleveland community, serving on the boards of the Greater Cleveland Partnership, Kaulig Giving and Empower Sports.
