# Benesch Partner Kevin Frankel Quoted in Coverage of State Actions Against Prediction Markets

The *Rockford Register Star* highlighted insights from Benesch Partner [Kevin Frankel](#), in its recent reporting on Illinois regulators' determination that online prediction markets violate state law. Frankel, who closely follows nationwide enforcement trends in emerging digital-market litigation, offered perspective on how state attorneys general coordinate in multistate actions.

"...We have seen similar situations in other nationwide litigation where a few lead states do the heavy lifting and the rest of the AGs pile on later," said Kevin Frankel, a partner at the national firm Benesch Friedlander Coplan & Aronoff, who has written about the prediction market litigation. "Of course, a particularly activist state government could decide to grab the bull by the horns and attempt to create good case law in their district/circuit."
