The article explores a growing legal battle over who regulates sports-related “prediction markets” like Kalshi—are they financial products overseen by the federal Commodity Futures Trading Commission (CFTC), or are they essentially sports betting subject to state gambling laws?

“Kevin noted, ‘These contracts definitely look like swaps but also resemble sports betting, raising the central question of who has regulatory authority.’”
