Benesch Partner Mark Silberman Quoted in Healio on DOJ's \$6.5 Billion Healthcare Fraud Enforcement Sweep

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Mark Silberman, Vice Chair of Benesch's Healthcare Practice Group, was recently quoted in the Healio article, "*DOJ's \$6.5B Medicaid fraud sweep raises compliance stakes for 'honest mistakes'.*" The article explores the DOJ's nationwide healthcare fraud crackdown and the challenges providers face in complying with complex Medicare and Medicaid regulations.

Silberman noted that healthcare providers face an increasingly complex regulatory environment, making it important to distinguish intentional fraud from inadvertent compliance mistakes. He explained that even a single misunderstanding of a documentation requirement or reimbursement rule can be repeated across numerous patient encounters, significantly increasing providers' exposure to enforcement actions.
