The BTI Litigation Outlook 2025 is built on extensive surveys and phone interviews with top legal decision-makers from large organizations with over \$1 billion in revenue. The analysis draws from over 24,000 corporate counsel client interviews conducted over 23 years. Each year, BTI targets
