Jon also served from 1993 to 2006 as Senior Vice President and General Counsel for NCR Corporation, where he was responsible for furnishing legal counsel services and directing legal operations for all global divisions of the company. He also served as General Counsel of AT&T's Federal Systems Division, where he led a group of attorneys to support AT&T's provision of

products and services to the United States Government. Prior to joining AT&T, Jon was a Partner of the law firm Sidley & Austin, LLP and also worked for Heritage Communications, a cable television provider.

Recently, Jon has co-founded UpLevel Ops, which is a consulting firm specializing in providing services for in-house legal departments and law firms.
