

## Juan Morado Jr. Re-Appointed to CBA Board

The Association’s membership consists largely of lawyers and judges from Cook County and the state of Illinois. The Board of Managers consists of 16 members elected by the membership, and six officers including the president, first vice-president, second vice-president, secretary, treasurer and immediate past president.

The board also includes current Mayor of the City of Chicago Lori Lightfoot, as well as a United States Bankruptcy Judge for the Northern District of Illinois, and two sitting judges from the Circuit Court of Cook County.

“I am delighted that the CBA and its board of managers will be keeping Juan on the team,” Ruiz said. “His drive to make a positive difference-within our profession and across the community-is tremendous, as is the depth of his legal skill and policy insight. Overall, Juan’s deep knowledge of health care policy and regulatory matters, along with his deep community ties made him a uniquely qualified candidate.
