Benesch Partner [Kevin Frankel](#), chair of the [State Attorneys General Practice](#), was quoted in *ReadWrite*'s recent article exploring the widening gray area between criminal match fixing and geopolitical insider trading. The piece examines how unusual, well-timed trades tied to major political announcements challenge traditional enforcement in decentralized, often anonymous markets.

Frankel offered a clear standard for assessing trader intent:

"If the trader is the person with the ability to create the outcome, inside information should be assumed."
