Kristopher Chandler, chair of Benesch's AI Commission, was quoted in the piece highlighting the difficulties companies face in navigating inconsistent legal frameworks

Chandler noted, “It’s challenging to advise in-house counsel on AI risks when there are so many different state laws coming out on the technology. Meanwhile, there’s also a number of states that don’t have any artificial intelligence laws specifically on the books, and they’re leveraging old laws that may not be carefully structured in a way to account for the nuances of artificial intelligence.”

The article underscores how companies are grappling with uncertainty as lawmakers race to regulate AI technologies at varying speeds and levels of detail.
