Description:	During this session we will examine restrictive covenants through the lens of transactional risk allocation and post-closing enforceability, focusing on how these provisions operate across the full deal lifecycle, from diligence through integration. The session will analyze how restrictive covenants are structured, negotiated, and enforced across key deal documents, including purchase agreements, employment agreements, equity incentive awards, LLC agreements, and separation arrangements. Particular attention will be given to the tension between enforceability and deal protection, including jurisdictional constraints, evolving legislative trends, and practical drafting tradeoffs.
